## Community Broadcasters, LLC Sun Safety Policy

## Rationale:

Skin cancer is the most common cancer in the United States. Exposure to ultraviolet (UV) radiation in sunlight causes nearly all skin cancer cases. The risk for skin cancer can be greatly reduced when certain precautions are practiced. Therefore, Community Broadcaster's, LLC is committed to promoting sun safe practices to visitors and staff and will implement the following sun safety policy.

## Policy:

- 1. Community Broadcasters, LLC will promote basic personal strategies for preventing skin cancer for visitors: Apply full-spectrum (UVA & UVB) sunscreen (SPF 15 or greater) to exposed skin 30 minutes before going outside in the sun.
- 2. Visitors will be encouraged and reminded to practice basic personal strategies for preventing skin cancer through on-site communications (ex: verbal reminders, signage, brochures, etc.) at strategic locations (ex: waiting areas, restrooms, etc.)
- 3. If appropriate, site will make sunscreen accessible by providing sunscreen to visitors to encourage them to practice sun safety while participating in outdoor recreation activities.

## **Policy Monitoring and Review:**
