Policy Passed: Sun Safety | Outdoor Recreation and Outdoor Worksite

Rationale:

Skin Cancer is the most common cancer in the United States. Exposure to ultraviolet (UV) radiation in sunlight causes nearly all skin cancer cases. The risk for skin cancer can be greatly reduced when certain precautions are practiced. Therefore, Back Barn Brewing Company is committed to promoting sun safety practices to visitors and employees and will implement the following sun safety policy to take actions against cancer.

Policy:

Back Barn Brewing Company will promote basic personal strategies for preventing skin cancer for visitors and employees during outdoor activities for recreation and outdoor work assignments. Visitors and employees will be encouraged to wear sun protective clothing including sunglasses, lightweight long sleeve shirts and pants, and wide brimmed hats. In addition, visitors and employees will be encouraged to apply sunscreen with a minimum of SPF15 and seek out shade often. Sunscreen and shade materials are available for visitors and employees to utilize.

Communication:

Back Barn Brewing Company will communicate sun safety practices through emails with employees and on-site signage for visitors as well as social media posts.

Planning:

Back Barn Brewing Company will plan outdoor activities for visitors and staff including an assessment of shade availability of existing shade areas and the possibility of shade products for high-use areas during future expansions.

Policy Monitoring and Review:

Back Barn Brewing Company will evaluate and revise this policy on an annual basis.
